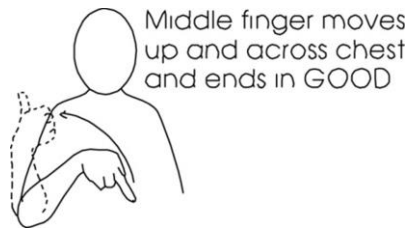
Can your child teach you the song at home?

To the tune of Frere Jacques and supported by Makaton signs

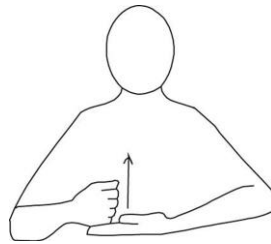
“We are gentle, we are gentle

For gentle – there isn't really a sign; it is more of a gesture. We tend to use a soft stroke down the arm.

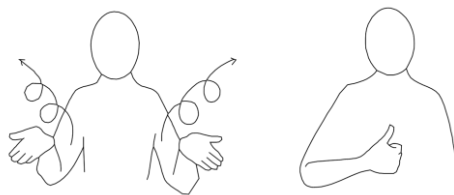
We are kind, we are kind
