What have Reception been up to this week?

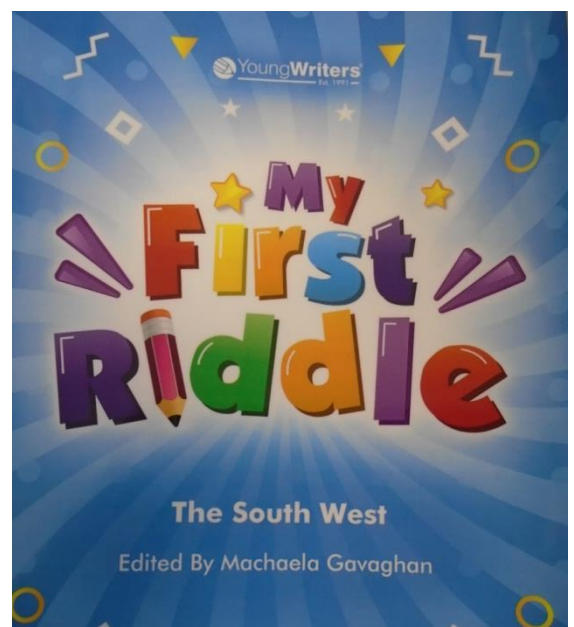

The items donated are distributed all over the world for re-use! Our school also receives an amount of money depending on the weight. This will be spent on new resources for our children



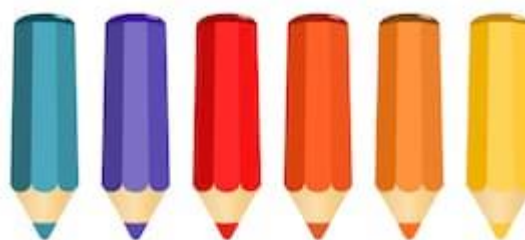

Coming home today are the instructions, user name and password for your child to access the Mathletics programme. We hope you and your child will enjoy this programme.



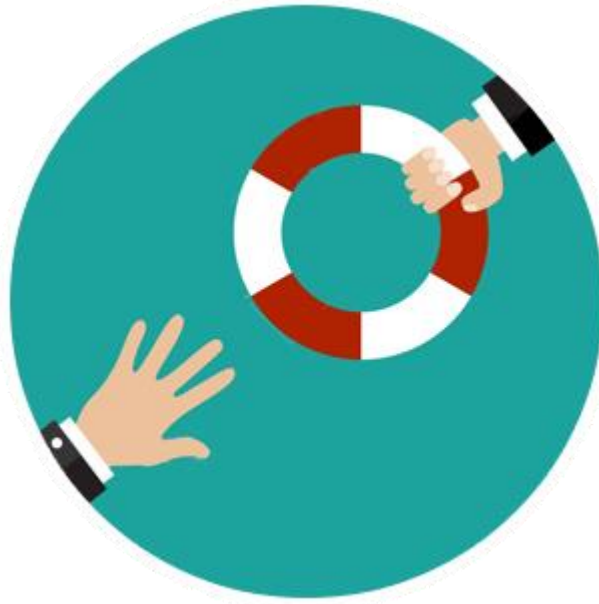
If your child entered the colouring competition at Country Store Health Foods in Redruth, there is a gift waiting for them in the Health Shop.
