(Ice cream)



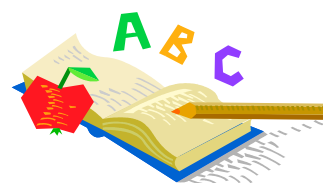
## Pupil Premium Funding
