

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The GDPR will apply from 25 May 2018 and will affect the way that we process staff & pupil's personal data. Its overall aim is to make sure that our sensitive data is kept safe and secure.

It's similar to the Data Protection Act (DPA) 1998 in many ways – most of the differences involve the GDPR building on or strengthening the principles of the DPA.

Data Information audits will be carried out regularly to check what personal data we hold, where it came from, why we need it, who we share it with, how long it is kept for and how it is looked after.

Subject Access Requests

A Subject Access Request (SAR) is when a data subject (or their parent) requests a copy of all (or specific) information we hold on them.
